REVIEW REPORT TO THE COMMITTEE MEMBERS OF THE SAMARITAN BEFRIENDERS HONG KONG

We have audited the financial statements of The Samaritan Befrienders Hong Kong (the "Organization") for the year ended March 31, 2019 and have issued an unqualified auditors' report thereon dated June 28, 2019.

We conducted our review of the attached Annual Financial Report on pages 3 to 12 of the Suicide Crisis Intervention Centre (the "Centre") of the Organization for the year ended March 31, 2019 in accordance with Practice Note 851 "Review of the Annual Financial Reports of Non-governmental Organizations" issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The review includes considering the procedures and records relevant to the preparation of the Annual Financial Report and performing procedures to satisfy ourselves that the Annual Financial Report has been properly prepared from the books and records of the Organization, on which the above audited financial statements of the Organization are based.

Review conclusions

On the basis of the results of our review and having regard to the audit procedures performed by us in relation to the audit of the financial statements of the Organization for the year ended March 31, 2019:

- a. in our opinion the Annual Financial Report has been properly prepared from the books and records of the Organization; and
- b. no matters have come to our attention during the course of our review, which cause us to believe that the Organization has not:
 - i. properly accounted for the receipt of Lump Sum Grant, Provident Fund, and other social welfare subventions and expenditure of the Centre in respect of Funding and Services Agreement activities and support services;
 - ii. kept separate Operating Income and Expenditure Account for each subvented service unit as required by the Lump Sum Grant Manual (LSG Manual) published by the Social Welfare Department of the Government of the HKSAR;
 - iii. prepared the Annual Financial Report in accordance with the format and requirements set out in the LSG Manual; and
 - iv. employed the staff quoted in the Provident Fund arrangements during the year ended March 31, 2019.

NOTES ON THE ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT

1. LUMP SUM GRANT (LSG)

a. Basis of preparation

The Annual Financial Report (AFR) is prepared in respect of all Funding and Service Agreement (FSA) activities (including support services to FSA activities) funded by the Social Welfare Department (SWD) under the Lump Sum Grant Subvention System. AFR is prepared on cash basis, that is, income is recognised upon receipt of cash and expenditure is recognised when expenses are paid. Non-cash items like depreciation, provisions and accruals have not been included in the AFR.

b. <u>Lump Sum Grant (excluding Provident Fund)</u>

This represents LSG (excluding Provident Fund) received for the year.

c. Provident Fund

This is provident fund received and contributed during the year.

Snapshot staff are defined as those staff occupying recognised or holding against subvented posts as at April 1, 2000.

6.8% and other posts represent those staff that are employed after April 1, 2000.

The Provident Fund received and contributed for staff under the Central Items have been shown under Note (3).

2. FEE INCOME

This represents social welfare fee income received for the year in respect of the fees and charges recognised for the purpose of subvention as set out in the LSG Manual.

3. CENTRAL ITEMS

These are subvented service activities which are not included in LSG and are subject to their own procedures as set out in other SWD's papers and correspondence with the NGOs. The Provident Fund received and contributed for staff under the Central Items have been separately included as part of the income and expenditure of the relevant items (paragraph 3.14 of LSG Manual (October 2016)). There are no income received and expenditure paid for the year.

4. RENT AND RATES

This represents the amount paid by SWD in respect of premises recognised by SWD. Expenditure on rent and rates in respect of premises not recognised by SWD have not been included in AFR.

5. OTHER INCOME

This includes programme income and all income other than recognised social welfare fee income received during the year. Non-SWD subventions and donations received have not been included as Other Income in AFR. In this respect, donations have been included if it is used to finance expenditure reflected in AFR.
